You can also hire web developers to create a website for you based on your specifications, which you can then host on your webhosting account.

You must make changes in your domain name control panel after installing CMS or uploading your web pages to your hosting account so that your domain name points to your webhosting service. Name servers are responsible for this. Your webhosting provider will instruct you on how to change the name servers in your domain name control panel.

When your domain name begins to point to your website, it is ready to be served on the Internet. Is a domain name and webhosting service, however, sufficient to create a website? Yes, it is sufficient for a personal website and occasionally for some business websites, but you still require a few additional items to complete your website creation. You'll need a personalized email address for your domain name so that website visitors can contact you. You can use Google Apps or another email client to create personalized emails.

With all of this, you may need an autoresponder account. An autoresponder is software that responds to emails on your behalf. It automatically collects email addresses from visitors to your website and sends them information or sales letters that you specify in your autoresponder account. This is useful if you need to follow up with website visitors in order to persuade them to purchase your services or products. A domain name costs approximately \$10 per year, a good webhosting service costs approximately \$3 per month, and an autoresponder account costs approximately \$15 per month.
